Machinery Directive

The Machinery Directive (and other similar EU legislation) applies to products when they are placed on the market or put into service in the EU. Consequently, the Directive applies to all new products placed on the market or put into service in the EU and also to products that have been used outside the EU if they are placed on the market or put into service in the EU. The Directive does not apply to products that have been used in the EU and that are sold second-hand in the EU – see §72 of the Guide to application of the Machinery Directive: http://ec.europa.eu/enterprise/sectors/mechanical/machinery/index_en.htm Second-hand machinery only bears the CE marking if it was subject to the Machinery Directive when it was placed on the market new. Second-hand machinery that was placed on the market in the EU before the Machinery Directive became applicable (and that does not bear the CE marking) may have been subject to national regulations when it was placed on the market. Certain Member States may also have national regulations on the sale of second-hand machinery. Otherwise, such machinery is subject to the national regulations implementing the minimum requirements of Directive 2009/104/EC on the use of work equipment – see §140 of the Guide.

Discover the Provençal backcountry and its wine area by quad 250 cm3! Welcome by our Quad instructors on the premises, short briefing and initiation in Quad driving. Off you go for an exciting ride through beautiful Provençal nature: hills, woods, vineyards, rivers...

Dinner in the countryside Cannes, Mougins medieval village

Just 20 minutes behind Cannes in the countryside, this picturesque Provençal village is like a spiral-shaped seashell built on a conical hill, in the past surrounded by ramparts. It has attracted great names of the art world, including Picasso, Léger, Dior... Its Provençal atmosphere and narrow flower-filled streets, art-galleries and inviting restaurants give it indescribable charm. Since in 1969 Star Cook *Roger Vergé* opened the famous *Moulin de Mougins*, the village has been a **Mecca for gourmets**. Each year, the *International Gastronomy Festival* takes place here, meeting place of French and international renowned chefs. A large choice of good-quality restaurants attract gourmets all year around.

The principality of Monaco and Eze village – Cap Ferrat and Villefranche

Nice-Monaco: Panoramic ride along the Middle Corniche road past the medieval village of **Eze**, with its spectacular setting on top of a cliff dominating the sea.

Visit of Eze: a fortified gate marks the entrance to its vaulted cobbled streets and stone houses with art and souvenir shops. While climbing the narrow alleys, notice the vistas on mountain and sea. On the highest point are the remnants of the castle and the **exotic garden**: here the coastline and glittering sea, spread before your eyes like a map.

The Principality of Monaco, squeezed between sea and mountains, is one of the world's smallest states. The historical Old town **Monaco-Ville** with the **Prince's Palace** is perched on the **Rock** of Monaco. From here, beautiful **panorama** on the port, Monte-Carlo and the quarter Fontvieille. Other points of interest in the Old town are the **Cathedral** where the Monegasque sovereigns are buried, including Princess Grace and Prince Rainier; the **Oceanographic Museum** with a world-wide reputation for its collections of marine fauna, gathered by Prince Albert 1 (Rainier's great grandfather) Its famous **Aquarium** with the rarest species of fish in all shapes and colors and the **Shark Lagoon**. From the top floor there is a magnificent **panorama** of the Principality all the way to Italy. Changing of the guards in front of the Palace each day at noon. The *Belle Epoque* quarter of **Monte-Carlo** boasts the mythical, most famous **Casino** in the world, haunt of the Rich and Famous since 1879. The impressive atrium, the Europe Lounge with its frescoes and gilding illuminated by crystal chandeliers, all add to an impression of elegance and grandeur.

Return ride along the Lower Corniche road, passing **Cap Ferrat** and **Villefranche**.
